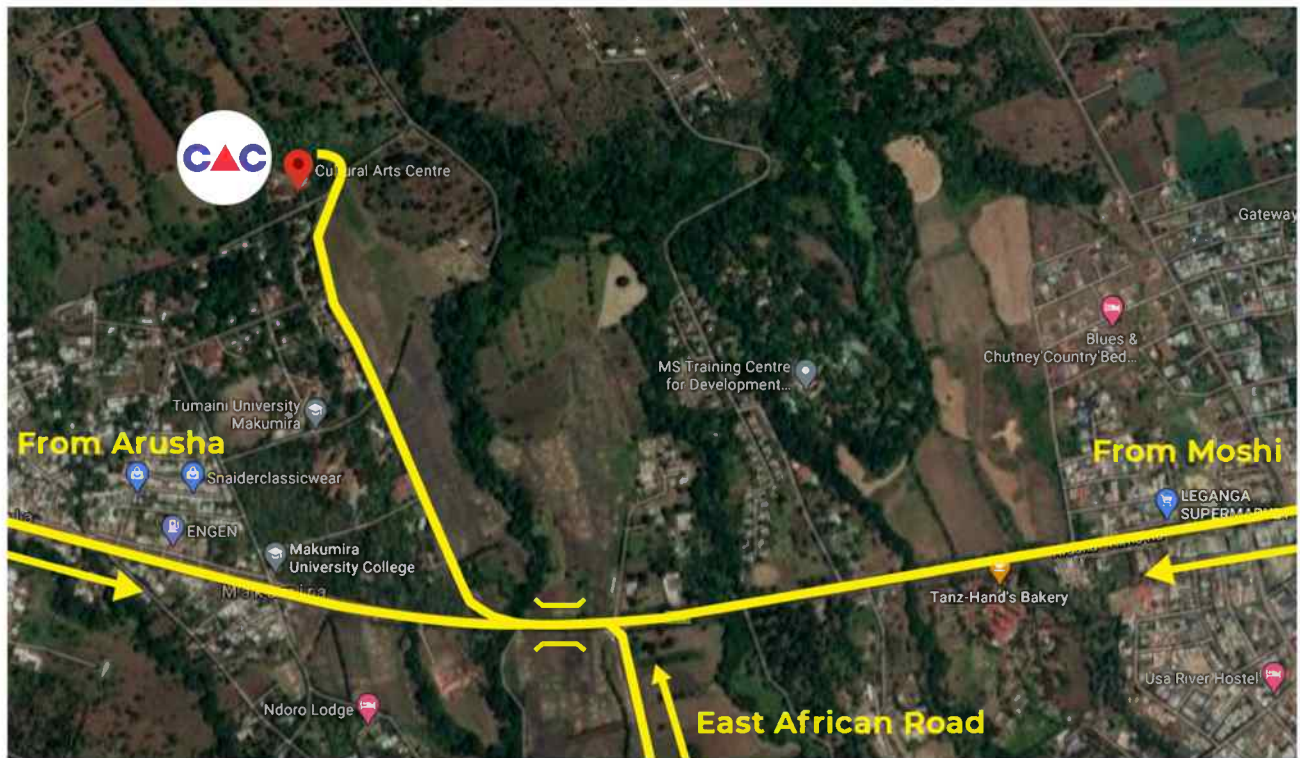

Experience the energy and excitement of the 15 - member professional CAC dance/music team at our state-of-the-art open theatre in Arusha.

The CAC dancer/musicians have given over 600 performances since 2015, specializing in traditional dances from all parts of Tanzania.

A 1 hour show typically includes dances from 7 different ethnic groups.



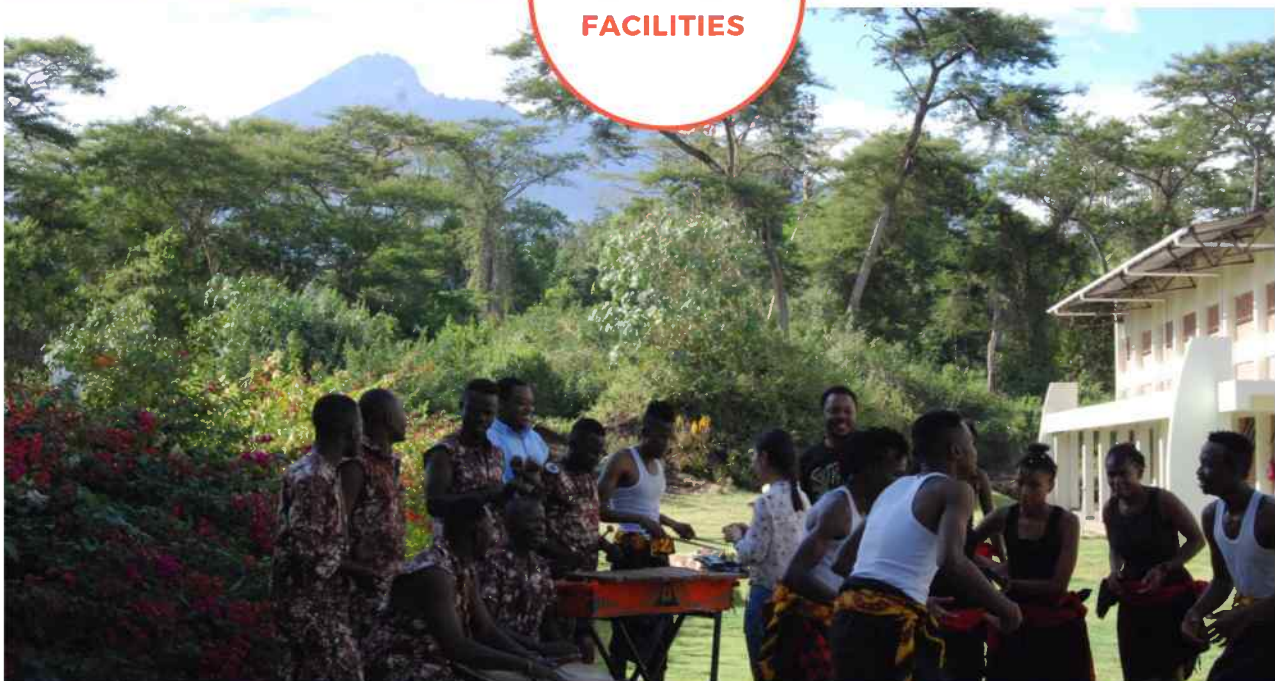
The CAC dancers also travel throughout East Africa for festivals events, conferences exhibitions and festivals. They have welcomed Presidents, Ministers, Ambassadors and other special guests. CAC fusion adds modern instruments with traditional tunes and instruments for another level of excitement.



The CAC is about sharing Tanzanian Culture with international guests and Tanzanians. Come to learn traditional ethnic dances, drumming, making traditional drums, cooking and eating traditional foods. We also have 6 traditional houses (Bomas) of Meru, Maasai and Waarusha ethnic groups on-site. The CAC has the largest collection of traditional Tanzanian instruments in the country, and musicians to demonstrate all of them!



The CAC can accommodate groups of 2 to 200 for all workshops and activities in our beautiful open air outdoor facilities.



The Cultural Arts Centre of Makumira is located on 5.5 hectares with lush vegetation. The unique buildings have cultural connections, such as the performance hall in the shape of a Maasai shield and the large "drum" building. Landscaping, gardens, and the outdoor facilities complement the 4 permanent buildings. All facilities have handicapped accessibility and all required COVID-19 protocols are in place. We have a beautiful and unique setting.



The CAC open air Performance Hall seating 435 persons (200 persons with social distancing) with a large 13 x 7.6 metre and state-of-the-art sound, lighting and projection. An adjacent amphitheater adds additional grass seating for 200 persons. Backstage are dressing rooms with toilets and showers.



The CAC Conference Room can accommodate 75 persons in lecture format or 30 persons at trapezoid tables. Sound, projection, flip charts, chai and meals also can be arranged. Large, clean restrooms include both western and natural positions toilets and a separate handicap/family bathroom.



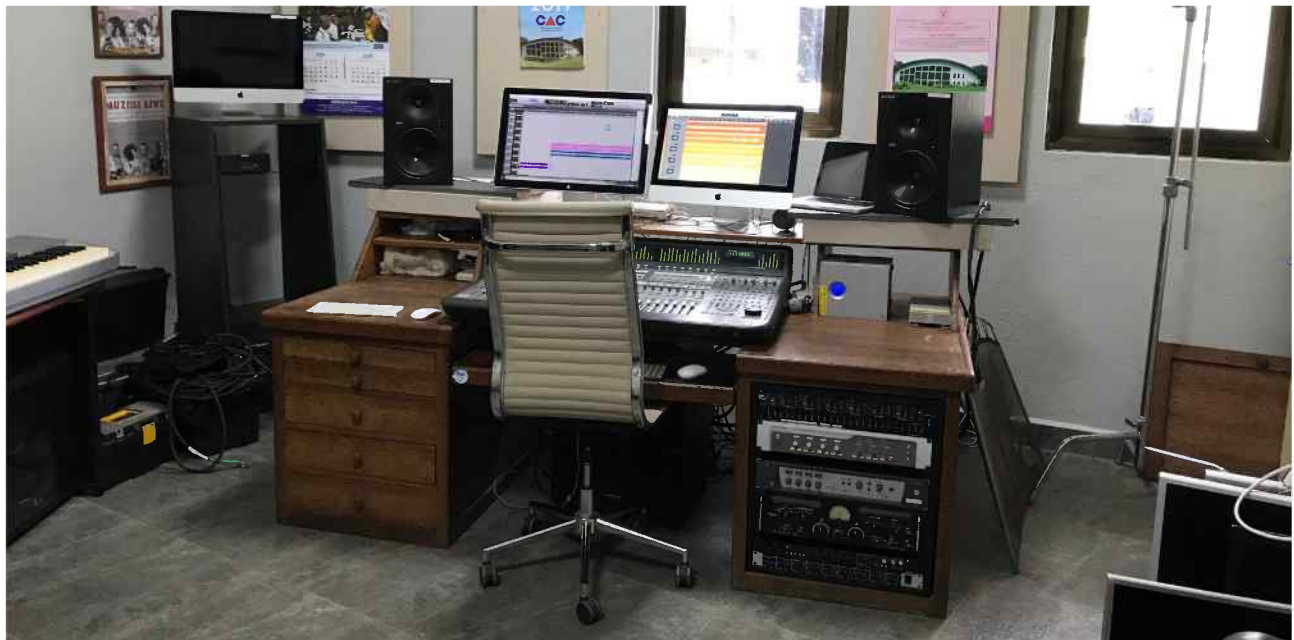

The CAC Dance Studio is 12 x 7.5 meters and has a wood sprung floor and two walls of full length mirrors plus changing rooms.



The CAC has a professional stage available for rental at your site the can be configured to different sizes and heights and is sturdy enough for enthusiastic dancing. 25 sections of stage (1M x 2M), carpet or linoleum covering, stage skirting and steps are included.

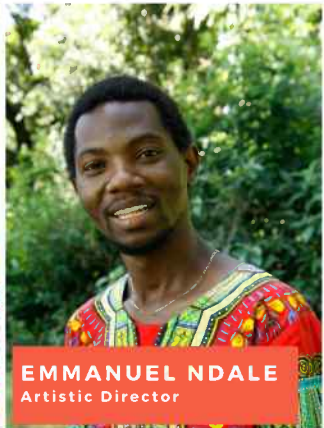

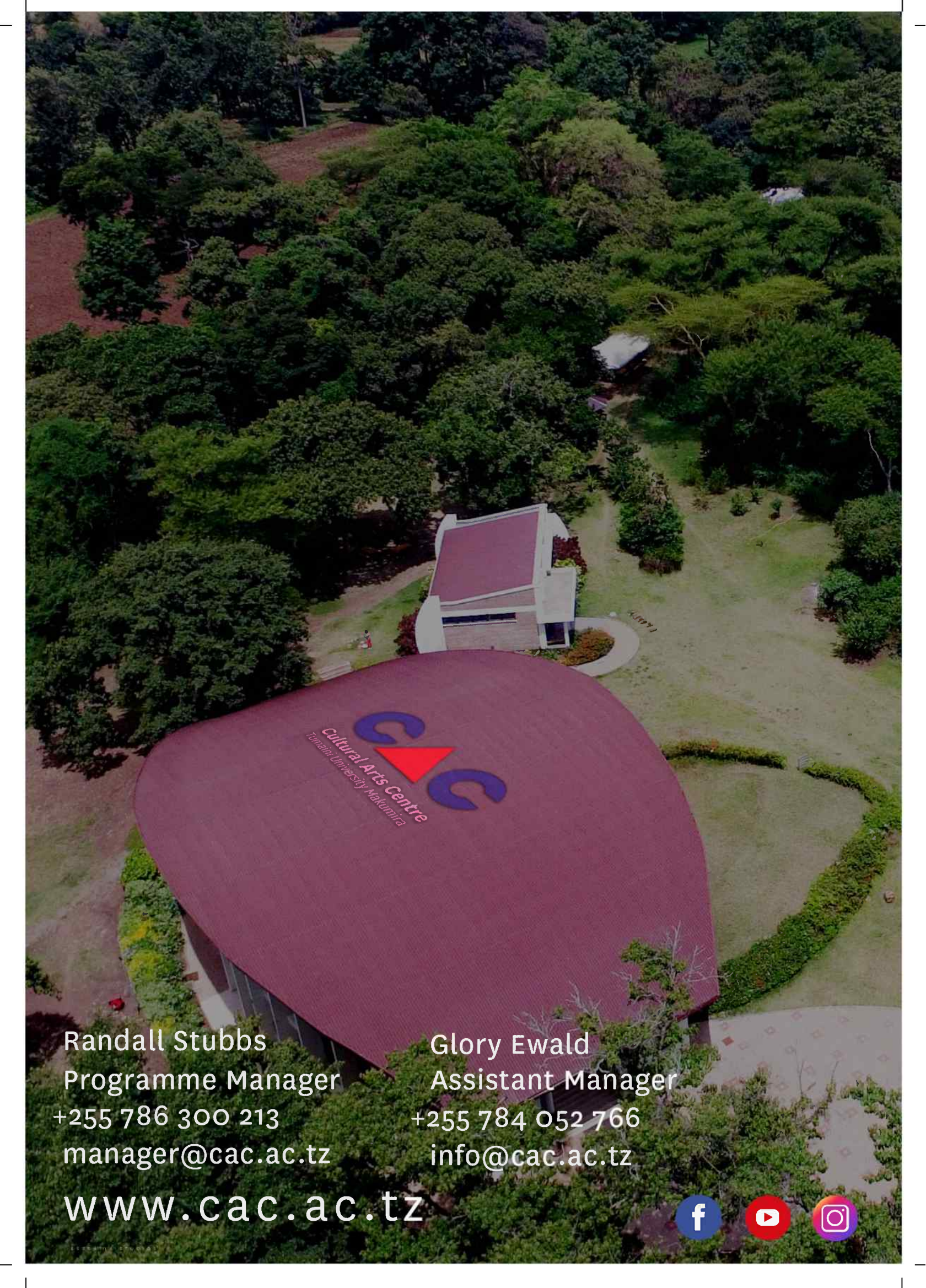


The CAC has an impressive array of Chauvex digital lighting, from fixed floods to computer controlled moveable lights, we can make your event look amazing.
